

Norfolk Minerals and Waste Local Plan

Proposed Main Modifications

Representations Period: 9am on 17 October to 5pm on 13 December 2024

The proposed Main Modifications to the Norfolk Minerals and Waste Local Plan (NM&WLP) have been published for representations to be made from 17 October to 13 December 2024, as part of the examination of the NM&WLP by an independent Planning Inspector on behalf of the Secretary of State for the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government. Representations which are duly made will be submitted to the Planning Inspector and considered as part of the Examination of the NM&WLP.

The draft NM&WLP was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate in December 2023 for examination. Examination hearings took place in July 2024. As set out in the hearing sessions, there are a number of Main Modification required to the NM&WLP in order for the Inspector to consider it sound and legally compliant. Main Modifications are those which materially affect the policies in the NM&WLP. Proposed Main Modifications have therefore been prepared and published by Norfolk County Council, without prejudice to the Inspector's final conclusions on the NM&WLP which will consider the representations submitted.

Important Note: Representations must be received between 9am on Thursday 17 October and 5pm on Friday 13 December 2024. Representations received before or after these dates will not be considered. Representations cannot be treated as confidential.

How to complete the response form

There are two ways in which it is anticipated that you will respond to consultation on the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP, with your comments focusing on the soundness (as set out in paragraph 35 of the National Planning Policy Framework) and legal compliance of the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP.

If you are seeking to make representations on the way in which Norfolk County Council has prepared the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP it is likely that your comments or objections will relate to a matter of legal compliance.

If it is the actual content on which you wish to comment or object it is likely it will relate to whether the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP are 'sound', that is justified, effective, positively prepared, and consistent with national policy.

Section 1 and 2 – Please tell us your name and contact details, Representations are only valid if this information is supplied.

Section 3 – Please identify clearly which proposed Main Modification, paragraph and policy your comment relates to.

Section 4 – Please indicate if you consider that the proposed Main Modification you are responding to is legally compliant and meets all of the tests of soundness (set out in paragraph 35 of the NPPF).

Section 5 and 6 – Please state which of the four tests of soundness (justified, effective, positively prepared, or consistent with national policy) your representation relates to, why you consider the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP is not legally compliant or unsound and what changes are necessary to make the Main Modifications sound having regard for the test of soundness which you have identified.

Section 8 – Please read the privacy statement and sign and date the form.

The proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP have been published by Norfolk County Council for representations to be made on them as part of the examination of the NM&WLP by a Planning Inspector. The purpose of the examination is to consider whether the plan complies with the relevant legal requirements, including the duty to co-operate, and is sound. The Inspector will consider all representations on the proposed Main Modifications that are made within the period set by Norfolk County Council.

To ensure an effective and fair examination, it is important that the Planning Inspector and all other participants in the examination process can know who has made representations on the plan. Norfolk County Council will therefore ensure that the names of those making representations can be made available (including publication on Norfolk County Council's website) and taken into account by the Planning Inspector.



Statement of Representations Procedure and availability of documents

This statement has been prepared by Norfolk County Council pursuant to the <u>Town and Country Planning (Local Planning)</u> (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

Title of the document: Norfolk Minerals and Waste Local Plan – Proposed Main Modifications

Subject matter and area covered

The Norfolk Minerals and Waste Local Plan (NM&WLP) covers the whole of the administrative area of Norfolk County. The NM&WLP covers the period up to 2038 and includes a forecast of the quantities of minerals and waste that need to be planned for over the plan period to 2038. The NM&WLP contains criteria-based policies to be used to determine planning applications that come forward for waste management facilities. Specific sites are allocated for silica sand extraction, carstone extraction and sand and gravel extraction along with the policies to be used to determine planning applications for mineral extraction and associated development. This representations period is only regarding the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP. Main Modifications are those which materially affect the policies in the NM&WLP. The proposed Main Modifications affect a number of Policies and paragraphs in the NM&WLP. Main Modifications are proposed to the wording of the following policies: MW1, MW2, MW3, MW4, WP2, WP3, WP7, WP13, WP14, WP15, MP1, MP2, MPSS1, MP5, MP7, MP8, MIN12, MIN51/MIN13/MIN08, MIN96, SIL01 and MIN25.

Period of Publication for Representations

Representations of support or objection are invited for a period of 8 weeks from **9am Thursday 17 October until 5pm Friday 13 December 2024.**

Please note that representations received after this date will not be considered. Only representations received within this period have a statutory right to be considered by the Inspector at the Examination.

Representations at this stage should only be made on legal and procedural compliance of the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP, the soundness of the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP and whether the Main Modifications to the NM&WLP are in conformity with the Duty to Co-operate.

Things to consider when making a representation

When making representations on the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP, the following questions should be considered:

- Are the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP legally compliant?
 Do the Main Modifications to the NM&WLP comply with the relevant legislation and regulations in the way they have been prepared, and in their content?
- Are the proposed Main Modifications to the NM&WLP sound?
 The tests of soundness are set out in paragraph 35 of the <u>National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF)</u>. Plans are sound if they are:
 - Positively prepared providing a strategy which, as a minimum seeks to meet the area's objectively
 assessed needs, and is informed by agreements with other authorities, so that unmet need from
 neighbouring authorities is accommodated where it is practical to do so and is consistent with achieving
 sustainable development;
 - Justified an appropriate strategy, taking into account the reasonable alternatives, and based on proportionate evidence;
 - Effective deliverable over the plan period and based on effective joint working on cross-boundary strategic matters that have been dealt with rather than deferred, as evidenced by the statement of common ground; and
 - **Consistent with national policy** enabling the delivery of sustainable development in accordance with the policies in the NPPF.
