HEAVY GOODS VEHICLE (HGV) MANAGEMENT PLAN

Introduction

This Heavy Goods Vehicle Management Plan is prepared on behalf of Earsham Gravels Limited in connection with the ongoing "Call for Sites" process as part of the Mineral & Waste Local Plan being prepared by Norfolk County Council.

It is our Client's aim for the proposed expansion of operations at Mundham Quarry to be allocated within the emerging Local Plan. A planning application for the expansion would then be submitted in due course with appropriately detailed information.

The Site currently has planning permission to allow operations with access onto Mundham Road with routing between the Site and the A146 to the North-east. A comprehensive series of passing places are already installed on the section of road between the aforementioned access and the A146 (Principal Route). In connection with the proposed expansion of operations at Mundham Quarry, additional passing place improvements are proposed at two locations on Mundham Road, as deemed necessary by the Highway Authority.

The mineral extracted at Mundham is then typically sent for processing at Caistor St Edmund Quarry located approximately 12 miles to the North-west. This involves routing via the A146 towards Norwich, the A147 towards Martineau Lane roundabout, The Street and then through White Horse Lane at Trowse and then onto Caistor St Edmund Quarry off Stoke Road.

It should be noted that the Highway Authority's account of accident data for the past five years to end of September 2017 shows no recorded incidents involving HGVs along the prescribed route between Martineau Lane roundabout and Caistor St Edmund Quarry off Stoke Road. This is particularly significant with respect to the section of White Horse Lane between The Street at Trowse and the A146 underpass given this passes by the primary school and village green.

Indeed, Client records show no incidents involving Earsham Gravels Limited fleet HGVs to/from Mundham Quarry since operations began 15 years ago in 2002.

This HGV (i.e. vehicles having a gross weight of over 7.5 tonnes) Management Plan is prepared to outline those existing routing and operational arrangements adopted by Earsham Gravels Limited for this Site at Mundham that would also continue to be adopted and monitored as part of the future expansion of the Quarry.

General Access Arrangements

The following restrictions would apply:

I. All vehicles arriving and departing the quarry will do so using the existing entrance to the Site onto Mundham Road and by travelling directly to and from the A146 which lies to the Northeast of the Quarry;

All vehicles will thus avoid travelling through Mundham village which lies to the West of the Quarry. The "local" route to be followed is shown on the accompanying drawing ref: 1303/03/100 along showing the potential passing place improvements on Mundham Road. The overall "strategic" route between Mundham and Caistor St Edmund Quarry for materials processing is shown on drawing ref: 1303/03/200;

- II. The number of daily loads leaving the Quarry is not to exceed seven with an overall yearly output not exceeding thirty thousand tonnes;
- III. No vehicle movements will take place to or from the Site between Mondays to Fridays during school term times as published by the local education authority during certain hours of the morning and afternoon for a maximum of one hour in any such period as shall be agreed in writing from time to time by Norfolk County Council.

This will then limit the impact of HGV movements on key sensitive receptors such as the primary school on White Horse Lane, Trowse;

IV. All existing signing at the access to the Site shall continue to be maintained by the Applicant.

Controlling the Access Arrangements

A number of measures will be adopted by the Applicant to ensure all vehicles arriving and departing the Quarry adhere to the above General Access Arrangements.

These measures will comprise:


a) Regular monitoring by the Quarry Manager to ensure all vehicles are using the approved access routing arrangements;


The date, time and frequency of any breaches of the approved arrangements, where known, will be recorded in a site log, which will be made available for inspection to Monitoring and Control Officers of Norfolk County Council;

- b) All drivers of vehicles under the control of the Applicant will be made aware of the General Access Arrangements. This will be done by written instructions being handed to drivers; the arrangements being placed on Notice Boards in facilities used by the drivers and by verbal communication by the Quarry Manager;
- c) Any driver found not to be adhering to the General Access Arrangements, will be subject to reasonable lawful action to ensure future compliance with the General Access Arrangements.


1303/03/100 "Access Plan" 1303/03/200 "Access Plan (Strategic)" Highway Authority Accident Data
